


## Welcome!

We're so glad you are joining us for Pets & People Outdoors inaugural event, the First Annual Saddle Rock Dog Walk. This event supports the Wenatchee Valley Humane Society (WVHS) and Chelan-Douglas Land Trust (CDLT). Thousands of pets receive food, shelter, medical care, and a second chance at a loving family through WVHS each year. Thousands of people access our stunning open spaces each year through land and trails protected and conserved by CDLT. Registering and becoming a fundraiser makes a difference for pets and the outdoors in North Central Washington.

In the months and weeks before the largest petfriendly walk in NCW, individuals and teams will fundraise on behalf of WVHS and CDLT. Your fundraising page can mobilize your community to raise funds and make a difference.

This guide will give you know-how, strategies and motivation need to reach that goal. Let's get started!





#### SETTING UP YOUR PAGE

Your fundraising page is your canvas, and your story is the brushstrokes that captures hearts.

Each person who registers has an individual fundraising page. If you created or joined a team, you also have your team's fundraising page. Your fundraising page tells your story and collects donations. When a donor contributes to your campaign, they can donate to your team or credit it to a specific fundraiser.

#### TIPS FOR MAKING A SUCCESSFUL PAGE

- Make your fundraising page highly personal. Use photos and stories about why you or your organization is getting involved and why it's important to you.
- Change your profile picture to your team's mascot or logo.
- Set a specific fundraising goal to help your community rally around an attainable target.
- Donate first to show your commitment to the cause. Enlist key donors to make donations before you go public to gain momentum.
- Post updates on your campaign page to show donors your progress.
- Use a QR code or link to your fundraising page in a visible location.

## TIMELINE

- 1. Join or create a fundraising team.
- 2. Create individual fundraising page and set fundraising goal.
- 3. Add personal photos/videos and your story.
- 4. Donate to the campaign to gain momentum.
- 5. Publicly share your fundraising page on social media, including goal.
- 6. Send follow-up emails and share progress on social media.
- 7. Gather your furry friends and join your team on May 18th at Saddle Rock.
- 8. Send personalized thank you notes to supporters.

# **Tips for Success**

- Ask people to re-share your campaign on social media.
- Post often on social media.
- Remember to follow up if you don't hear from someone.
- People are more likely to donate if they think you are close to reaching your goal.



### LET'S GET STARTED!

Now that your page is set up, personalized, and ready to go, it's time to ask for donations. Ask your family, friends, coworkers, neighbors - anyone that connect with. You can send a text, direct message on social media, email, or even ask in person. Get creative and don't be afraid to ask twice. People are busy and want to support you but need a little reminding.

#### 10 easy ways to raise money for pets in need and to preserve our open spaces:

- 1. Post your fundraising page on Facebook and Instagram and share with your pet- and outdoors-loving friends.
- 2. Email or text your family members the link to your fundraising page and let them know you're on a mission to raise money for the Humane Society and Land Trust. Ask your family to support YOU. Even is they aren't animal lovers or hikers, they love you!
- 3. Ask your employer if they will match your team's donation. Let your people know that every dollar raised will be matched, incentivizing them to donate more.
- 4. Have kiddos? Go door-to-door and ask your neighbors for donations. Offline donations can be mailed or brought to the Humane Society and added to your online campaign. Who could say no to those cute faces?
- 5. With your co-workers, set up a taco bar lunch (or brunch, or salad bar, or smoothies) and ask your colleagues for a donation in exchange for your delicious efforts.

- 6. **Host a party!** Call your besties and invite them over for a game night. Provide some snacks and drinks and ask for a suggested donation amount for your campaign.
- 7. Create a challenge for yourself. Whether it's a pushup for every dollar donated or baking cookies for each person that donates to you, commit to a task that creates an incentive for your friends and family to give.
- 8. Ask your manager to have a one-time "bring your pet to work day." Anyone who brings their dog to work contributes \$25 to your fundraising page. Studies show we're more productive when we're happy, and our pets make us happy!
- 9. Put together a basket full of goodies (spa package, date night basket, movie night date, lottery tickets, etc), sell raffle tickets to your co-workers, friends, clients, and neighbors, and draw a lucky winner right before the walk.
- 10. **Contact a local restaurant** and ask them to donate a percentage of sales on a specific day. Then tell your friends about the fundraising event and encourage them to go and support.

Be sure to always have your unique url handy so your friends and family can donate directly to your page.

## TALK THE TALK

Tell them WHY you're raising money for WVHS and CDLT and how their contribution will make an impact. Don't forget—send your unique URL that leads to your fundraising page and ask for donations from your friends and family. Feel free to use the following language to ask via texting, social media, and email, or get creative and create your own!

#### Texting:

Hey! I am raising money for the Wenatchee Valley Humane Society and Chelan-Douglas Land Trust.
